

Frequently Asked Questions:

When will I know if I received my workshop choices? You will get a notification 3 to 4 weeks after sending in your registration. This notification will reserve your selection. On January 15 you will be notified if your class has been canceled. A class may be canceled due to low participation. After Jan.15 all classes are a go unless the teachers have unforeseen circumstances arising.

Can I get my homework early? Students fully paid starting Feb 1, will be eligible to receive homework, patterns and pre-instructional materials. Your teachers will be given all your contact information in Starting in February when paid in full.

Can I get my Patterns by Mail instead of Email? Yes, but you may be asked to pay an additional fee for printing and mailing. Most teachers email their patterns and instructions to their students to keep the kit fee as low as possible.

Can I register after the deadline? Yes, but beware! Classes start closing on March 15. Some classes require homework, or special supplies may be difficult for the teacher to obtain for the kit on late notice. Therefore, we set a deadline. Classes with no homework or little homework remain open, right up to the convention. We try and keep them open if possible.

How do I know if a class is full or canceled? The web site is updated daily. They will be clearly marked in Red.

How will I know what to bring to my classes? Supply lists will be posted on the web site no later than Jan 30. You will also get copies via email or mail.

I need to talk to the Instructor. Can I? Contact information will be on your supply list so that you can contact your teacher directly if need be.

Can I cancel? Cancellations are inevitable. There is a \$75.00 **non-refundable** deposit. Anything over the \$75.00 will be refunded 100% until March 15. If a class is canceled and we cannot find a replacement class that you wish to take, the deposit will be refunded also.

Return Check fees: There is a \$30.00 return check fee charged for any checks that are returned.

Sewing Machine-Can I Rent? Not this year. None of the classes require sewing machines in class but if you are taking a class with sewing and you have not finished your homework you better bring your machine.

Kit Fees? Kit fees are paid to the instructor in class. Some instructors ask you to mail a check directly to them prior to the event. Others can be paid at AFICC. You will receive information on payment with your supply list.

Are the classes in the hotel? Yes.

Can I just send checks and make payments to bring my March 15 payment down slowly? Yes
