14" Soft Sculpture Doll
1/4 yd. Woven Cotton Fabric for Skin
1/8 yd. Silk Dupione for Corset
1/4 yd. Silk Chiffon for Bloomers and Sleeve Puffs
1 square Wool Felt for Hat
1 square Wool Felt for Spats
Scrap of Contrast Silk for Ruff and Hat Band

8 Bead Caps and 4 beads for Knee and Elbow Joints
(Barbara will bring)

Four 1/2" Two Hole Buttons for Hip and Shoulder Joints

Carpet Thread, Beading Thread, Sinew or other heavy-duty thread for beaded joints

1/4" Silk Ribbon for Joints and Corset String
6 inches of Tibetan Lamb for Hair
Trims for Spats, Hat, Shoulders and anywhere else you fancy



Pigma Pens size 01 - brown, black, blue or green and red or pink
Berol Prisma Pencils - pink or red, shade slightly darker than skin color, blue, blue/gray, brown, olive, dark blue for Wode Tattoos

White gel roller pen or white acrylic paint and very small round paintbrush

Stuffing

Marking Pens - air and water-soluble

Scissors - fabric, pinking, clipping, and paper

Hemostats, Stuffing Tools

3" or 5" Doll Sculpting Needle

8 Chenille Stems

Regular Sewing Supplies - Sewing machine, seam ripper, matching threads, pins, needles, etc.
