“Adorable Dollies” Dot is one of Suellen’s creations offered in a one-day classes. Sew at two heads at home so in the morning you will be able to draw a flat face then repeat the process so that you have the skills perfected. By afternoon you will be working on the completion of the doll. Suellen will walk you step by step through the face drawing process and you will learn to break a few rules. In the afternoon you will work on simple sculpting and blushing the body, assembling clothes and all. The hair is applied with an easy hand stitched method.

General Sewing Kit- Scissors, Needles, Air erase Marker, candy etc.

Sewing machine – to sew homework only – not needed in class

Doll Making Supplies – Hemostats, finger turning tools (or coffee stirrer and toothpick).

1/3 yard of 100% cotton woven fabric in flesh town (this will make more than one doll).

Fabric for Dress and hat ½ yard or 2 fat quarters will be more than enough.

Scrap of Fabric for panties

½ yard 1-inch wide ribbon for hat

Small buttons, ribbons and trinkets for embellishments

Baby elastic (or 1/8- inch ribbon) for patties

Stuffing and stuffing tools

Chenille Stems or pipe cleaners

Matching thread for the body and clothing

Novelty yarn for hair

A 3 to 5 inch- long needle.

Prisma color pencils (or Derwent watercolor pencils in similar colors)

Deco Peach

Rosy Beige

Peach

Chestnut

White

Sienna Brown

Process Red

Carmine Red

Canary Yellow
